Writer and Oral Historian

Marc Freeman is a noted writer and oral historian

He has been published in a broad range of prestigious print and online outlets — including **Vanity Fair, Forbes, Slate, Air Mail, the Hollywood Reporter, Huffington Post, The Nation, USA Today, The Seattle Times, Yahoo Entertainment** and **The White House Historical Quarterly**. His book publishers include **St. Martin's Press** and the **University of California Press**.

Freeman is eclectic in the subject matters that have engaged him as an author.

He has built a reputation for chronicling American pop culture, especially iconic television programs and films.

Quite separately, he has developed a focus on documenting the intersect of twentieth century U.S. politics, law and civil liberties.

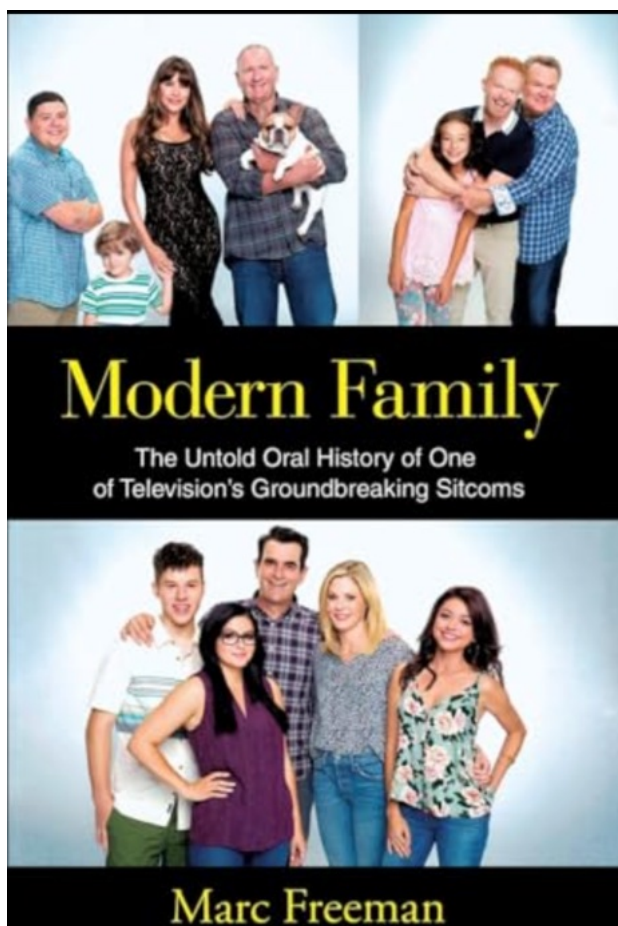
Whether deconstructing and celebrating the visual arts or exploring complex strands of American history, Freeman is noted for his forensic research, in-depth interviewing, detailed analysis and accessible writing style.

His credits include critically-acclaimed oral histories of groundbreaking television programs such as **M*A*S*H, Frasier, The West Wing,** and **The Smothers Brothers Comedy Hour**. His oral history of the sitcom **Modern Family** was a successful book published in 2020 by St. Martin's Press

His next book is the first-ever biography of the heralded American civil liberties lawyer **Leonard Weinglass** - famed for his role in prominent legal cases over four decades. He was at the heart of some of the twentieth century's most prominent causes célèbres including the **Chicago Seven, the Pentagon Papers, Watergate, Daniel Ellsberg, Jane Fonda, Patty Hearst, Angela Davis, Mumia Abu-Jamal, Cuban Five**.

The biography will be published in 2028 to coincide with the 60th anniversary of the 1968 Chicago DNC protests and police riots that helped establish Weinglass as a leading voice in defense of victims of political persecution.

Freeman was born and raised in Los Angeles. He is the son of pioneering Hollywood movie marketing executive - the late **Allan Freeman**. He graduated cum laude from the respected liberal arts institution Pomona College where he majored in Modern American History with a minor in Film/Media Studies. He is the brother of the renowned historian and Alexander Hamilton scholar - Yale Professor **Joanne Freeman**. He lives in Seattle. He is married with one daughter.
